- Title of paper.
- Author's (and co-author's) name, address, affiliation, fax number, telephone number, and e-mail address.
- Two JEL code classifications – a complete list of JEL codes is available at: http://www.aeaweb.org/journal/jel_class_system.html
- An abstract of the paper

Without the above information, abstracts will not be accepted.

Note: There is no submission fee for accepted papers submitted through these sessions. However, all the participants of Bangladeshi origin must become AEDSB member. Please note that upon acceptance of the paper, the presenter will need to pay the registration fee for the conference to be able to present their paper at the conference.

The **deadline for submission** is **March 15, 2023**. The author(s) will be notified by March 30, 2023. We are *open to all topics* (i.e., the paper does not have to be on Bangladesh or a Development issue).

Graduate students and job market candidates are strongly encouraged to take this opportunity. This will be helpful for resume building and enhance presentation skills. The job market candidates will have the opportunity to practice before going for job interviews in January and subsequent campus visits. In addition, attending the SEA conference is also an excellent place for networking for young professionals and graduate students.
